You are hereby informed that **Saturday 19th December 2020** students of Class-IX will start their Diagnostic Test Series following the **schedule & syllabus** given above. You are requested to note the following guidelines in this regard:

- 1. The test is **not** optional and taking this test is **mandatory** for all students of Class-IX.
- 2. The test shall be of **1 hr.** (1 hr. 15 min for mathematics & 1 hr. 30 min for 2nd language). **Students will have an additional reading time of 10 min.**
- 3. The test for the respective subjects will be for a Full Marks of 40.
- 4. Students will be questioned only on the reduced syllabus for the respective subjects.
- 5. Students must attempt their answers on the Loose Sheet of the Single-lined Long Notebook.
- 6. Students must write their answers with Black Ball Point Pen only.
- 7. The **1**st **Page** of the answer script must have these details –Student Name, Class, Subject & Date).
- 8. The question paper for **Subject-1 will be uploaded at 09:20 a.m.**
- 9. Students will have writing time starting from 09:30 a.m. and end at 10:30 a.m. for a 1 hr. paper.
- 10. The question paper for **Subject-2 will be uploaded at 11:05 a.m.**
- 11. Students will have the writing time starting from 11:15 a.m. and end at 12:15 p.m. for a 1 hr. paper.
- 12. The loose sheets of the answer scripts must be numbered and arranged in sequence before tying/stapling them together. The answer scripts for Subject-1 and Subject-2 should be tied/stapled separately.
- 13. Both sets of the tied/stapled answer scripts must be submitted by <u>02:00</u> <u>p.m.</u> at any of the Units of our school (**Bypass, Central Avenue, Metiabruz** or **Park Circus Unit**) that is nearest your place of residence or one that is convenient to you (Answer scripts will not be accepted after 02:00 p.m.)
